

## What to Expect on a Volunteering Day with Us







**Location Options:** Stockroom or Charity Shop

#### **Stockroom Activities:**

- Checking Donations: Ensure donated items meet our quality standards.
- Packing Referrals: Prepare packages with essential items for families.
- Organising Inventory: Help keep our stockroom tidy and efficient.

#### **Charity Shop Activities:**

- Customer Assistance: Help customers find items and manage purchases.
- Merchandising: Arrange and display items to attract shoppers.
- Stock Management: Assist with pricing, tagging, and organising stock.

#### **General Information:**

- **Timing:** Sessions typically run from 10-3 (10-2 shop), with a lunch break.
- Dress Code: Wear comfortable clothing and shoes suitable for physical work.
- Facilities: Tea, coffee and water are provided. Bring your own lunch or visit nearby eateries.
- **Group Size:** Optimal for groups up to 6 people (Stockroom) 2 people (Shop).
- **Guidance:** Volunteers will be supervised by a member of the Little Stars team.
